ADELAIDE VIGIL

Thirty people attended the vigil staged in Adelaide and in other Australian cities to protest Israel's 40-year occupation of the remaining Palestinian lands. A mock-up wall (2.4m x 2.4m) was erected which displayed enlarged photos of the Wall going up around the West Bank and East Jerusalem. More than 700 postcards showing the disappearing map of Palestine were distributed and Democrat senator Sandra Kanck took 65 of these postcards to give to every politician in South Australia. A few politicians came out and took part in the protest.

In the evening a documentary screening took place.
